## 17. INCREASING BID THRESHOLD-QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT

WHEREAS, Stephen J. Brennan, MBA, CPA, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary possesses a qualified purchasing agent (QPA) certificate;
