STUDENT EXPECTATIONS FOR REMOTE LEARNING DAYS



- Students will access either the their teachers' Websites, Class Dojo, or Class Links to retrieve the Google Classroom Codes for this school year and any parent communication for the teacher's main learning platform.
- At the start of each Remote Learning Day, students will review the lessons from each of their teachers on the Google Classrooms. These lessons will be posted on Google Classroom/Class DoJo by 9 am each Remote Learning Day. Activity on the Google Classrooms/Class Dojo will allow teachers to "take attendance each day."
- Students will work on the lessons provided by all of their teachers for a total of *at least* two hours each Remote Learning Day. Students will be required to work on lessons for a total of ten hours per week.
- Students/parents will communicate with their teachers through Gmail, Class Dojo, and Google Classroom and ask for support as needed. Teachers will be checking their email and Google Classrooms several times a day.
- Students will continue to check the progress on their assessments through feedback on Google Classroom, Class Dojo, as well as the grade portal in Realtime.
- Students/Parents can still contact their CST case manager/counselor or administration for additional support as needed through email.
- Bass River staff emails can be found on the district website. Clicking on each teacher's name will link to their gmail. All staff have the same email format: flast@brsdnj.org (first initial, lastname@brsdnj.org)
- Students will repeat this process each Remote Learning Day, each weekday that school would normally be in session until school reopens.
